THIS WEEK’S LESSON AT A GLANCE

Lesson Title: God Creates Everything Good

Bible Passage(s): Genesis 1

Big Idea: God created everything on purpose, in perfect order, and made people to reflect His love. Jesus, the Creator, shows us how much God cares for us.

MEMORY VERSE

“In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth.”

— Genesis 1:1

Tip for Parents:

Say the verse together during the week. Ask your child what God created on each day and thank Him in prayer.

TODAY YOUR CHILD LEARNED

This week your child learned that the Bible begins with God creating the world in six real days. They learned what God created on each day and how everything God made works together with purpose and care. They also learned that people are made in God’s image, which means we are created to reflect God’s love, kindness, and care to others.

WHY THIS MATTERS FOR YOUR FAMILY

Genesis 1 teaches that life is not an accident. God created the world intentionally and made people special. This lesson helps children trust the Bible, understand their value, and see Jesus as both Creator and Savior. The same Jesus who created the world later gave His life on the cross and rose again so we could be forgiven and restored to God.

TALK ABOUT IT AT HOME

Family Discussion Question:

What is something God created that helps other things live?

Optional Follow-Up Question (Older Children):

What does it mean to reflect God by how we treat other people?

DEFENDING THE TRUTH (AT HOME)

A Question Children Often Ask:

Could everything have happened by accident?

A Simple Biblical Answer:

No. The world shows order, purpose, and design that point to a wise Creator. Everything works together the way God planned.

Scripture to Read Together:

Genesis 1:1

Psalm 19:1

Romans 1:20

TRY THIS AS A FAMILY

Take a short walk or look outside together. Point out ways creation works together (plants, animals, sunlight, water). Talk about how God designed everything with care.

PRAYER TO PRAY TOGETHER

God, thank You for creating the world and making us in Your image. Help our family love others and reflect You in how we live. Thank You for Jesus, who made us and saves us. Amen.

ENCOURAGEMENT FOR PARENTS

You are not walking this journey alone. God is at work in your child's heart. As you talk about God's Word together, He is shaping faith that will last.
