3. What did Jesus tell them to do?
4. What did Jesus promise to make them?
5. How did Simon and Andrew respond to Jesus?
6. What were James and John doing when Jesus called them?
7. How did James and John respond?

Write your answers in your own words.

Part 2: Read Luke 5:1–11

Read **Luke 5:1–11** two times.

Then answer these questions.

1. What had Simon and the other fishermen been doing before Jesus came?
2. What did Jesus tell Simon to do in verse 4?
3. Why did Simon seem unsure about doing what Jesus said?
4. What happened after Simon obeyed Jesus?
5. How did Simon Peter respond to Jesus in verse 8?
6. What did Jesus tell Simon in verse 10?
7. According to verse 11, what did Simon, James, and John do?
