Week 13 | March 29, 2026 | Jesus the Promised King Enters Jerusalem | Matthew 21:1-11

WHAT WE LEARNED TODAY

Today your child learned that Jesus entered Jerusalem as the promised King. He came humbly, riding on a donkey, just as God had promised long before in Scripture. The people shouted "Hosanna," which means "save us," and they welcomed Him with joy.

But Palm Sunday is more than a happy crowd and waving branches. Jesus knew His death was near. He knew the cross was coming, and He came anyway. He entered Jerusalem on purpose because He loved sinners and came to save us.

Big Truth from Today's Lesson

Jesus is the promised King who came humbly to save sinners.

MEMORY VERSE

***"See, your king comes to you,
gentle and riding on a donkey."***

Matthew 21:5

WHAT THIS MEANS

Jesus is not only a good teacher or a kind man. He is the King God promised. He came first in humility to die on the cross for our sins and rise again. One day He will come again in glory.

QUESTIONS YOU CAN ASK AT HOME

Who entered Jerusalem?

Jesus entered Jerusalem.

What does "Hosanna" mean?

"Hosanna" means "save us" or "save now."

Why did Jesus ride on a donkey?

Jesus rode on a donkey to show He is the promised King and that He came humbly.

Why does Palm Sunday matter?

Palm Sunday matters because it begins Holy Week and leads us to the cross and the resurrection.

How do we know Jesus came on purpose?

Jesus came on purpose because He knew the cross was near and still came in love to save sinners.

FAMILY ENCOURAGEMENT

Your child does not need to grow up in fear or confusion about who Jesus is. The Bible shows us clearly that Jesus is the promised King, the Savior, and the Son of God. He is gentle, strong, and worthy of trust.

This week, remind your child that Jesus did not avoid the cross. He moved toward it in love. That means His love is not small, weak, or uncertain. It is strong enough to save.

A SIMPLE WAY TO PRAY TOGETHER

Lord Jesus, thank You for coming as the promised King. Thank You for loving us so much that You went to the cross to save sinners. Help our family trust You and follow You. Amen.
